But the IRS Criminal Investigation is quite different: they are federal law enforcement agents just like their colleagues in the FBI, DEA and numerous others.</p> <p>The IRS Intelligence Unit was created in 1919, to investigate widespread fraud associated with the new federal income tax. It attained national prominence in the thirties for the conviction of public enemy number one, Al Capone, for income tax evasion, and its role in solving the Lindbergh kidnapping. In 1978, the Intelligence Unit changed its name to Criminal Investigation (CI).</p> <p>Trained at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) in Glynco, GA. as federal financial investigators, CI special agents fill a unique niche in the federal law enforcement community. Special counsel Bob Mueller has enlisted the help of agents from the IRS' Criminal Investigations unit according to sources familiar with his investigation into alleged Russian election interference</p> <p>Come and hear how we accountants might interface with Special Agents of the IRS-CID.</p>
